Registration

Competition Registration

Online entries are made through the <https://pannonian.hr> website.

Then the registration form has to be filled in online.

For minors, parental permission is required and must be sent to email sport@pannonian.hr

NOTE for BMX:

A valid cycling license, as defined in Part I of the UCI Regulations will be required and must be presented at rider confirmation to check their identity.

An identity card or passport is also mandatory.

A rider whose license could not be verified and whose status as a non-suspended license holder cannot be established in any other manner may not start and may not figure in the classification of the event.

NOTE: Entry in the competition implies agreement with the event schedule, regulations and all provisions of the Technical Guide.

Event Check In

On the event day, all registered competitors are required to Check In. This is simply done by visiting the Pannonian Challenge info table. The staff will check your registration and waiver form. If both are complete and no further information is required, you will be provided with a wrist band.

This wristband will be your pass for the duration of the event – please do not take it off or lose it.



Competition Requirements

- 1) By participating in this event, you agree to be bound by all Pannonian Challenge and UCI Regulations and Policies.
- 2) By participating you agree to be bound by all Pannonian Challenge Terms and Conditions.
- 3) Each participant is engaged on their own behalf and those of their employees and agents, and must observe all the provisions of the Technical Guide and BMX Freestyle Regulations.
- 4) Every participant shall follow the directions of the organization and appointed officials, and any penalties that may be applied.
- 5) Ignorance of the provisions of the Technical Guide or the event schedule shall not be admitted as an excuse by any rider in any circumstances.
- 6) You certify that you have no contraindications (medical or otherwise) to practice a sport in competition.
- 7) You authorize the intervention of first aid, and if necessary, your transfer to medical services at the sole discretion of the event staff and event first aid personnel.
- 8) You authorize Pannonian Challenge and any other event Partners to:
 - film and / or photograph you.
 - reproduce, exploit and disseminate whatever the medium, or the content produced.
 - use your image and the said product contents whether for commercial and/or promotional purposes.
- 9) You will not disrupt the run / practice of another rider.
- 10) You are responsible for the supply of your own safety equipment.
- 11) You will not endanger any audience member or other participants during your run / practice.
- 12) You will not swear, act aggressively, or act in any way that may damage the reputation of Pannonian Challenge and any other partners. This will be enforced at the sole discretion of the event organizer.



13) You agree that you have entered this event on your own free will and you grant this from this day you will not ask for any remuneration or financial contribution from Pannonian Challenge or any other event partners.

Penalties for violation of these requirements could include disqualification from the event, stripping of prizes / prize money that you may have been awarded and bans from future events.

Competition Waiver

By entering this event, you understand that you, and each participant in the activities, will be engaging in activities involving a real risk of serious injury or even death from various causes including but not limited to equipment failure, accidents with other participants, spectators, course or weather conditions or other causes.

You voluntarily accept all risks necessarily flowing from your participation, which could result in loss of life or injury.

You also agree to be bound by all conditions & provisions in the standard Pannonian Challenge Wavier – these Conditions will apply to this Competition equally.

The overall composition of the runs is most important as the judges evaluate the sequences of tricks, the amount of risk in the routine, and how the rider uses the course. The judges take errors such as falls and stops into consideration.

Osijek

About Osijek: Osijek is the fourth largest city in Croatia with a population of 108,048 in 2011. It is the largest city and the economic and cultural centre of the eastern Croatian region of Slavonia, as well as the administrative centre of Osijek-Baranja County. Osijek is located on the right bank of the river Drava.

Arrival: From Zagreb, Belgrade and Budapest to Osijek is 2.5 hours car drive, and from Sarajevo it would take you about 4 hours. The border with Hungary is 50 km away, from Serbia 35 km and from Bosnia and Herzegovina 100 km.

With Zagreb and other major cities in Croatia, Osijek is directly connected by rail lines and frequent bus lines. To the capital cities of neighbouring countries you can come with connecting public transport and a direct bus line you can get from Belgrade (SRB).

Airlines in the country connect Osijek with Zagreb, Rijeka, Split and Dubrovnik. From the airports in Zagreb, Budapest (Hungary), Belgrade (Serbia) and Tuzla (Bosnia and Herzegovina) you can come relatively quickly to Osijek.

By car: On the highways you have to pay a toll that's charged according to the rates of the Hrvatske autoceste company (Croatian Highways).



If you're driving from the west take the A3 - A5 highway (Ljubljana, SLO - Zagreb - Slavonski Brod - Đakovo - Osijek).

From west and east take a state road D2 (Graz, A - Maribor, SLO - Varaždin - Koprivnica - Virovitica - Našice - Osijek - Vukovar - Ilok - Novi Sad, SRB - Belgrade, SRB).

From the south and north take the state road D7 or the A5 highway (Bosanski Šamac, BiH - Slavonski Šamac - Đakovo - Osijek - Beli Manastir - Pecs, HU - Budapest, HU).

Moving around:

From Josipovac in the west of Osijek, through urban neighbourhoods Retfala, Upper Town, Tvrđa and Lower Town to the village of Sarvaš, Osijek is elongated along the river Drava for almost 25 km. On the longest route from Podravlje to Brijest and Čepin, the city of Osijek is 10 km wide. Therefore, the simplest way to get around the city is by public transport.

The city itself (Osijek) is cross-linked with about 40 km of cycling trails that stretch even in the suburbs.
